I'm well Rachel I want
You to write to me and tell
Me how you and Meiles malled
I's a getting a long and tell
Meiles to take that twenty
Dollars that I borrowed from
Him tell him to take it
Out of the tobacco when
He sells it and Rachel
You take as good care of thing^{es}
As you can tell I come
Home Rachel I will be a
Happy man if I git home
I safe with you again and
I hope that I will Rachel
I will send you a song and
It's It is a nice songe well
Rachel I would like to here
From you but I am a lookin
For a letter every day tell
